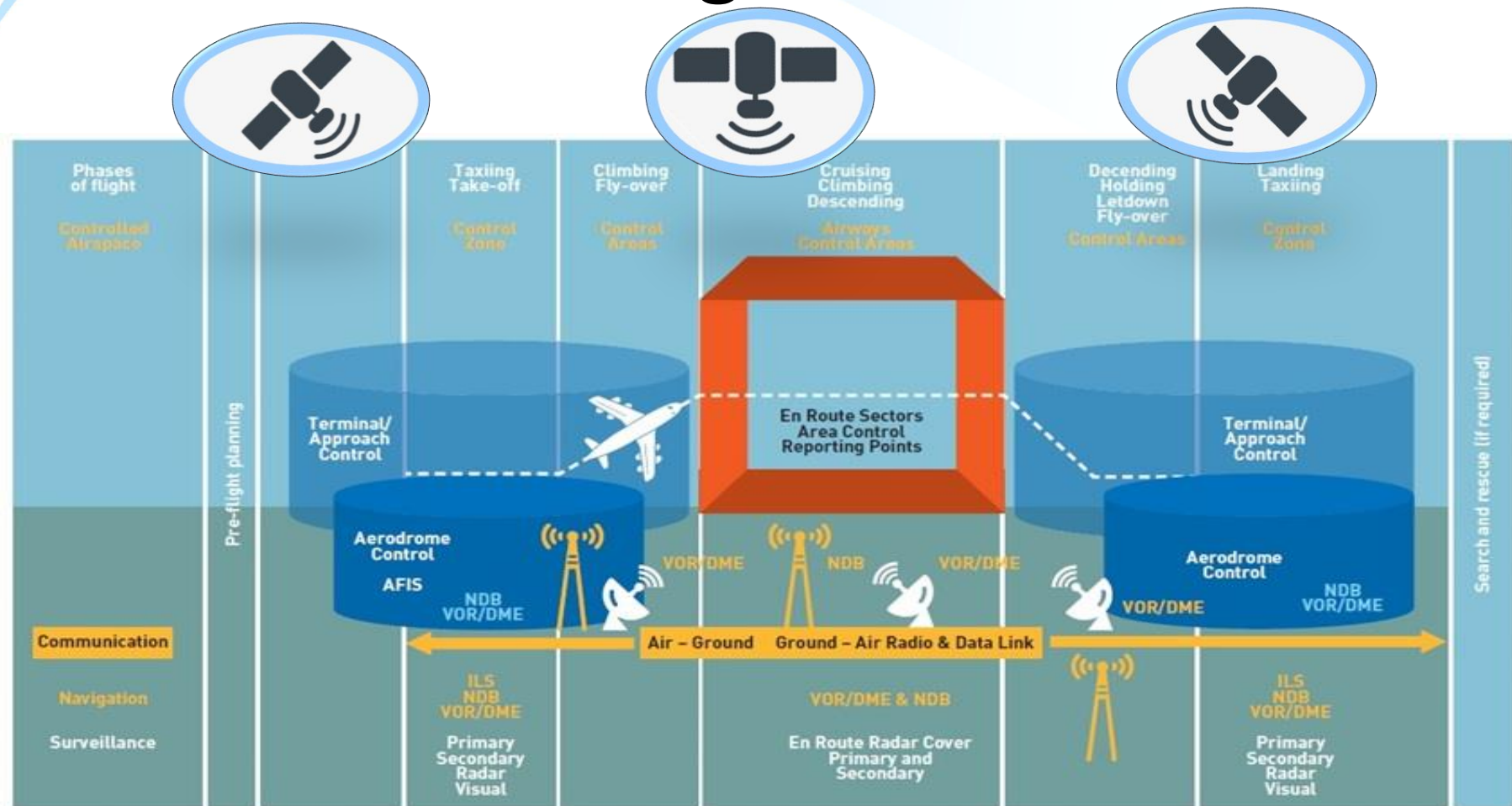

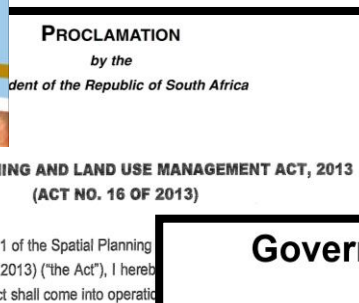
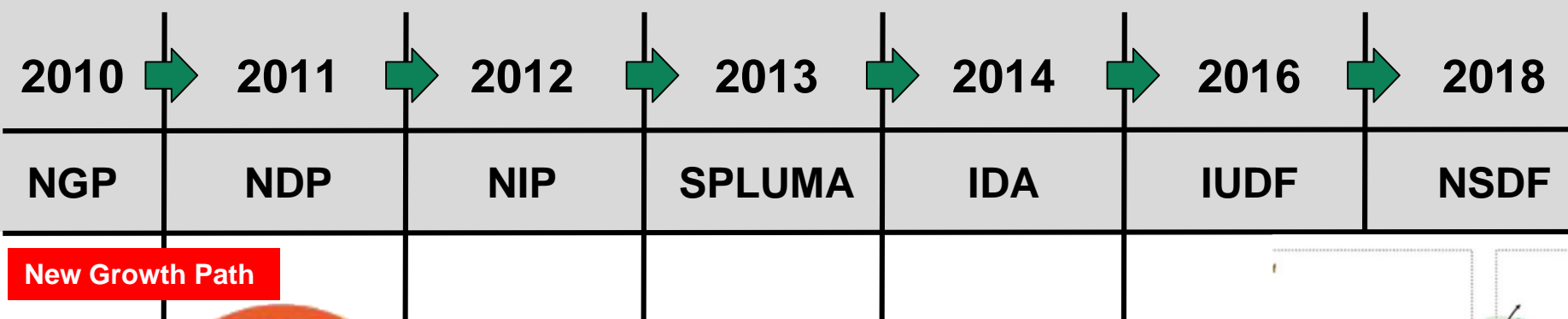
The Presidential Infrastructure Coordinating Commission (PICC)

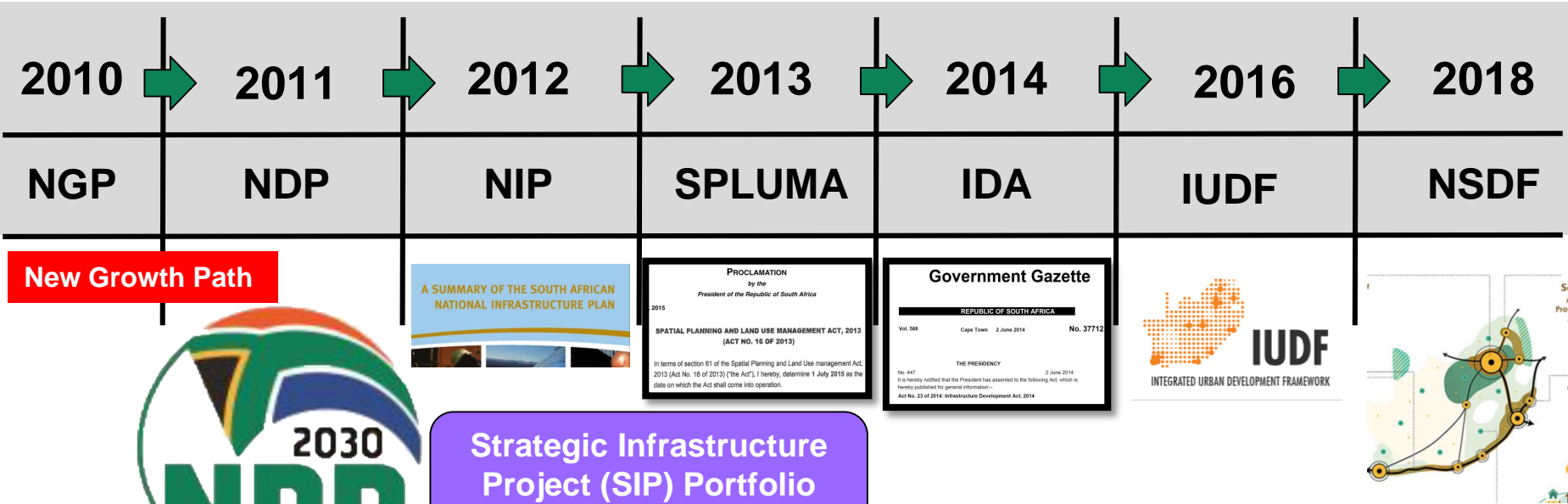


Policy evolution underpinning strategic infrastructure

Strategic infrastructure and the PICC



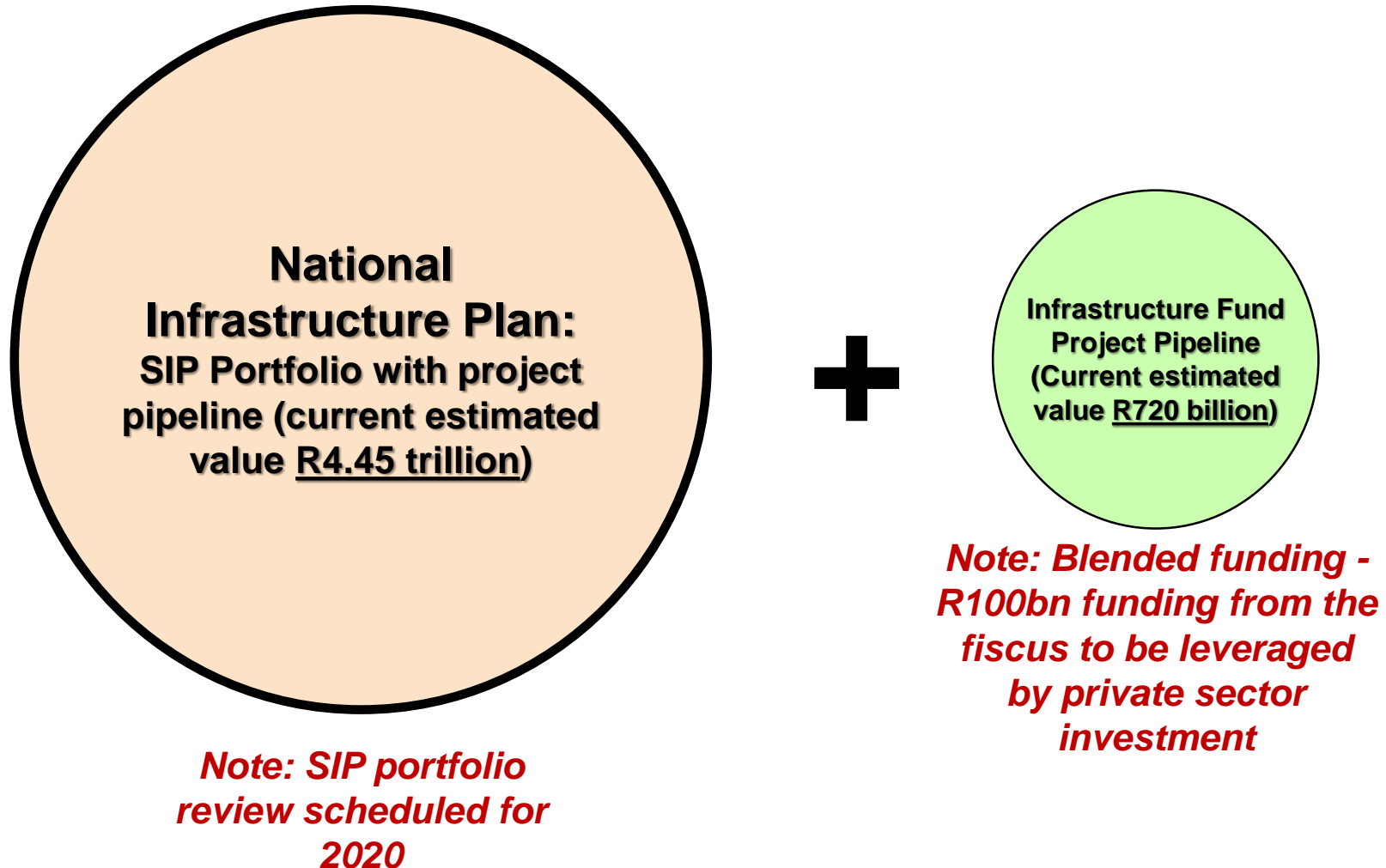

Objectives of the PICC GIS initiative to enable better planning, monitoring and decision making

- **Goal #1 - Building and maintaining accurate infrastructure GIS data and information:**
 - The GIS initiative is focused on building and maintaining the most accurate, consistent and reliable infrastructure geographic data and information in South Africa.
- **Goal #2 - Make GIS data and information accessible to all three spheres of government and / or tiers of users:**
 - Makes simple and easy-to-interpret-and-use data and information accessible to all stakeholders.
- **Goal #3 - Integrate GIS functionality with satellite imagery and other existing systems:**
 - The integration and inter-operability of GIS with existing government and business processes and systems is critical (eg National Treasury project financial monitoring, PICC dashboards and SIP reporting through coordination with key government departments, provinces and specialist teams)

Accessibility of PICC GIS information

- Secure PICC geospatial data and information will be accessible everywhere, with specifically tailored maps and information for key decision-makers, also when “out in the field”
- Access to information to be simple, integrated and secure
 - Maps, spatial data and information available on Apps (tablets, smartphones)
 - Maps, spatial data and information (products) available via an online portal
 - Viewing the evolution of specific locations over time (high resolution, up to date satellite imagery)

Empowering a Nation, triggering development



- The Infrastructure Plan is a bold effort to transform the economy, laying the basis for growth and jobs
- The Plan is an opportunity to mobilise the nation behind a common vision and requires partnerships with business, labour and communities
- Aimed at promoting:
